

## Quality & Engagement Manager – TBI-CPDM

The Quality and Engagement manager will work together with TBI Project Management Committee (PMC) and TBI Project Manager the following:

1. SOP development for medical regulation compliance (e.g. ISO13485)
2. Conceptualize, Ideate, build the QMS and ensure compliance by incubates
3. Setup learning and knowledge management
4. Conduct monthly boot-camps/mentoring sessions
5. Contact potential speakers and organize/co-ordinate seminars
6. Support infra setup and running of TBI

### Required skill:

For this position, we are looking for a person with a technical background and relevant substantial experience in medical device industry or start-ups. Salary will be commensurate with background and experience. Salary including performance variable compensation can go up to INR 50k per month (pro-rata) based on candidate profile. The position will be initially for one year, extendable for another year or more, based on performance. The minimum qualification is graduation in an engineering discipline. A postgraduate qualification and experience in design and implementation of quality management systems and processes is desirable.
